Welcome to Botswana's most accessible wilderness! Our accommodation lies an easy 10-minute drive from both the Chobe National Park entrance gate and Kasane International Airport in northern Botswana. It is a 90-kilometre drive to Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe.

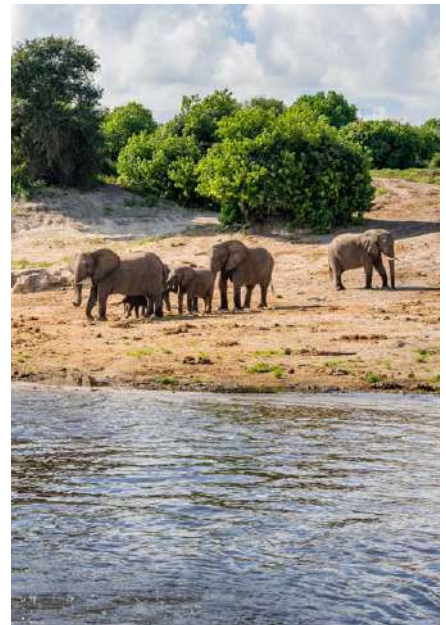


WONDERFUL WILDLIFE

The destination of your wildest dreams!

The lush Chobe Riverfront supports abundant wildlife and the largest elephant population on the planet. Thanks to the glittering ebb and flow of the Chobe River, grassy floodplains also attract immense buffalo herds and healthy antelope herds, in turn sustaining sizable resident predator populations.

The Chobe National Park is home to over 420 bird species. Whether cruising the water or strolling our indigenous gardens, there are fantastic bird photography opportunities and many easy-to-identify species. This might be the easiest place to become a bird watcher!

Chobe Safari Lodge serves scrumptious buffets for breakfast and dinner feasts from the central towering thatched dining room.

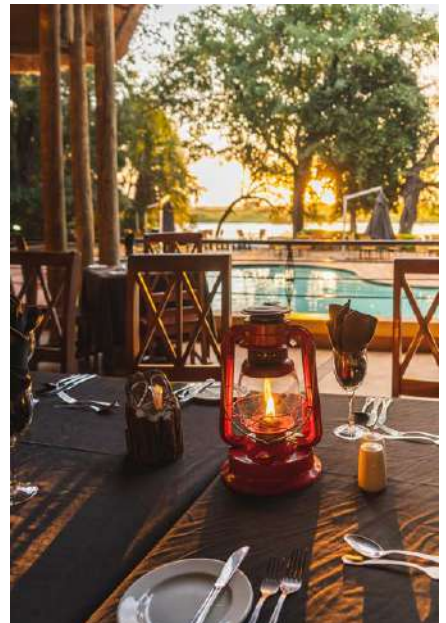
